

Responsibilities of Those Who Do Excavation Work

If you occasionally dig on your property, we need your help in preventing pipeline emergencies.

Records show that damage from excavation-related activities – particularly from equipment digging into pipelines – is the number one cause of pipeline accidents. Without proper coordination with our company, excavation activities in the vicinity of underground pipelines can result in very dangerous situations.

To determine if pipelines are located where excavation is planned:

- Look for pipeline markers at nearby roads, railroads and fences.
- Don't try to guess the route or location of the pipeline from where the markers are placed.
- At least 48 hours before you dig, call the pipeline company at the toll-free telephone number shown on the marker. At no charge to you, the company will send a representative to mark the exact location, route and depth of the pipeline.
